

How to Use:

- Do all 3 activities on April Fool's Day and trick your class 3 times!
 - Or, pick one and save the other 2 for another year.
- Multiple class periods? Pick a different activity for each class!

1) April Fools Word Search: The first four words are in the word search, but the rest are not! I like to have students complete the word search and say that the first to finish gets a huge reward!

2) April Fools Test: This test is labeled as 'Standardized Test Practice' to help students take it seriously. There are a set of directions to follow in one minute and the last direction is that you should have done nothing at all!

3) Common Knowledge Web Quest: Ask students to research the answers to these 10 questions. Trick is, each question is impossible to answer!


