
All book reports must include a one-page summary of the book. Your book report must include enough details to showcase your knowledge of the book.

Must include characters, setting, and plot.	6 Create a FOOD related to your story and bring it in for the class to share. Must be representative of the book.
7 Make a new BOOK JACKET for your book. Look in your local library for design inspiration.	8 Write a REVIEW of the book. Explain your favorite and least favorite parts of the plot, characters, ending, etc...	9 Conduct a fictional INTERVIEW with a main character. Ask questions related to the story.
